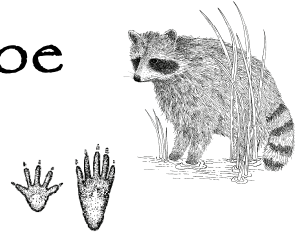




Mammals...From Head to Toe

a Skins, Skulls, and Tracks Workshop



Whether you live in a city, a small town, or in the country wildlife is all around you. Wild animals like raccoons, opossum, and skunks are frequent visitors even in large urban areas. And yet you may never actually see any of these animals. Wild animals can be difficult to detect because of their instinctive behavior to avoid humans. Most wildlife, especially mammals, rarely allow us to catch a glimpse of them, but they often leave evidence of their presence and clues to their activities - where they've been walking, running, resting, or rearing their young and what they've been eating. Join the Oklahoma Conservation Commission and the Rogers County Conservation District for a one-day workshop to learn how to identify some of Oklahoma's most common mammals from clues they leave behind. Come prepared to investigate skins, skulls and tracks in both indoor and outdoor settings as we look at Mammals...From Head to Toe.

Materials: Participants will receive skull and tracks field ID guides and activities/lesson plans. Participants will also make a set of plaster animal tracks to take home.

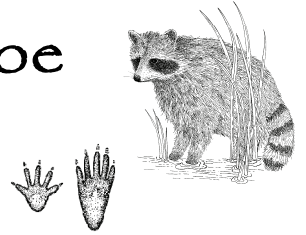
